Dear Church of the Resurrection Family,

We had an exciting Vestry Retreat on Saturday, January 25th. Your Vestry is wonderful, and we have many goals for 2025 all rooted in growing deeper in our relationship with Jesus. These



goals include building needs, engaging current members in deeper ministry, connecting with members we have not seen in a while, A Bring a Friend to Church Day, creating a newcomer's center in the Gathering Space, strengthening our stewardship ministry, and increasing our giving in multiple ways to our outreach ministries. The building needs include a new playground for the community (given by a generous donor), we are hoping to donate our current one to Macedonia Church, investigating and purchasing a new sound system for our sanctuary (also from the generosity of several donors), new tables for Emmaus Hall and more! We are excited about the year ahead and I hope you will work with us in these ministries to build the Kingdom of God!

In 2024, we had a surplus of \$15,000 because of much work done by the staff to find lots of saving costs! The Vestry voted to put \$5,000 in my discretionary account, \$5,000 to our buildings and grounds reserve fund and \$5,000 to our Choir Scholars funds to hire musicians for our Choir. This is exciting!

The Missional Partnership Committee gathered on January 12th to decide where the funding for our 2024 giving should go. The giving to our community is over \$27,000. These funds are from

our budget, the Oyster Roast, The Yard Sale, The Thanksgiving Day Race to be Thankful, Tee-shirt sales, The Lenten Project, The Advent Project and my Discretionary Account. Those organizations include the Greenwood Community Home Repair, Greater Greenwood United Ministries, The Food Bank, Community Initiatives, Healthy Learners, Holloway's Grocery for a Thanksgiving Meal, Canterbury Counseling Center, Meg's House, Pathway House, Greenwood County Humane Society, Resurrection Clothes Closet, Dolly Parton Imagination Library and The DSS Foster Care Program. These are only monetary donations, we have volunteered, gathered, and have been the hands of feet of Jesus! I am so proud of our hard work and our commitment to glorify God!

February is Black History Month. To celebrate Black History Month the Primetimers will be learning from Renee Robertson from The King Center on February 20th. As always, we will celebrate a Black Episcopalian weekly in our bulletin to learn more about our Black Brothers and Sisters. To quote Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. "I have decided to stick with love... hate is to great a burden to bear."

I love each and everyone of you deeply and I am so excited for the year to come as we grow deeper in our love for Jesus Christ!




