I am so excited to begin my time as Interim Rector with you in just a few weeks! It was wonderful to celebrate Jim Gobble's life with you last week. Although some of you have not spent time with me yet, I have been able to get to know much of your leadership, and I know that you are as proud of them as I am for the work they are doing in-between priests.

The Vestry has been working on overseeing updating the website, which is an important precursor to the search for your next Rector. Priests looking (and I am already getting calls!) will want to see a website that reflects the busy and vibrant culture of Resurrection in this moment. That is who you are! They are also pursuing the Holy Cow Survey you have heard about. This gives the congregation a chance to state hopes and dreams and will help the search committee to clearly state the kind of priest you are seeking.

Most of you know that I am coming to be your Interim Rector, but not what that looks like. The Bishop is graciously letting me work half time for you all and half time for him over the next months. Your Senior Warden and I plan that I will be present most Sundays (except for vacation days) and Mondays with regularity, I will be in Columbia on Tuesdays and Wednesdays and back with you for part of Thursday to make sure the bulletin is ready and attend to any pastoral care needs since Monday. The rest of Thursday will likely be off site sermonizing somewhere! Obviously, I will work hard to be present as soon as possible for emergencies, and I have been connected to your Senior Warden as support since November, and that will continue. I also am very excited to begin working with Denise and to plan liturgies with your new Music Director, Will Cleveland!

When I begin with you on April 19th, we will hit the ground running on your search process and I look forward to helping you in every possible way. You will get to see a bit of my husband as well, as this parish already feels like home to us.
