Dear Resurrection Family,

What does it mean to have an interim Rector?

It means that you have dedicated Sunday and mid-week coverage, pastoral care, administrative oversight (shared with the Vestry) and liturgy, which always falls under the responsibility of the Priest. Dr. Will and I are already joyfully planning ahead on liturgy!

I am typically (except over relocation or vacation times,) In the office from 9-3 on Monday and Wednesday. I hope over time to visit our home-bound parishioners, meet with every committee (and perhaps create one new one!) And generally be helpful to the good work so many at Resurrection provide to this community. Especially, I am trying to make the work of the Vestry a bit easier while they and the Search Committee seek your next Rector.

I will be here until the Vestry calls your next Rector. (Do not worry— they are not dragging their feet!). There are many things that I am trying to do to fill in the gaps, and a very few things that I cannot do as easily as a half-time and local Rector. Many of you know that I will be dividing my work time and home time between Greenwood, Columbia and Athens, GA. Greenwood is the “sweet spot” in so many ways for Shannon and for me, and we are so grateful!

One thing I have been tasked with by the Vestry is a Confirmation Class, which I would like to do a bit differently. There will be a class in the fall, more of an ‘Episcopal 101’ course, that will meet between the services. But I am really looking at my teaching time at Resurrection with a wider view. When the Bishop makes his next visitation, I hope we will have Confirmations, Receptions and Reaffirmations. Stay tuned on that!

We will begin this summer with a different Eucharistic Prayer. Enriching Our Worship I is a beautiful authorized (by General Convention) Rite that incorporates many of the beautiful words of Eucharistic Prayers A, B, C and D. We will be using a card in the pews between Memorial Day and Labor Day to access that prayer. After that, we will be switching to the Book of Common Prayer Eucharistic Prayers and reminding ourselves of the many gifts this resource gives us.

My prayer for you all as we go into the summer season is one of health, restoration and deep encounters with the Holy Spirit. The Paschal Candle will retire, and we will give up our double Alleluias after the Easter Season. . .But it is still Easter as I write this!
